

# Pastor's Vision Letter to New Creation In Christ Ministries

Dear Brother and Sisters in Christ:

We are humbled and honored that our Lord Jesus Christ has called us to Pastor New Creation in Christ Ministries. There are already many great Churches in our Valley that are building God's Kingdom. We want to make a difference too, and believe that we can through the power of the Holy Spirit. We believe we will be used by God in a mighty way to draw the lost to Him and bring healing to our community, state, and the world! Our prayer is that as we seek and obey Him, His power will be displayed through us. The Word of God reads in John 14:12, "I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father."

As Pastors, we will strive to do all things to the best of our ability, with a spirit of excellence, whole-heartedly as unto the Lord. We commit to pray fervently, study His Word faithfully, listen to His voice carefully, depend, trust, and obey Him totally, and fall in love with Him more intimately and passionately. We will share the message of love and hope which the name of this ministry so powerfully conveys as stated in 2 Corinthians 5:17, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation, the old has gone the new has come." We will build up quality, Godly servants, men and women, old and young, so that they understand and embrace their gifts, calling, anointing, and their role in the Body of Christ.

The Church leadership will be God called, God anointed and God appointed! They will be prayerfully considered and must bear fruit that lasts. They will lead by personal example in areas of Godly character, values, morals, ethics, and prayer. Men of Godly character will be built-up so that they will take their place as leaders in their homes, marriages, families, and communities through the biblical model of love, respect, and humility as stated in 1 Timothy 3. It reads, "1Here is a trustworthy saying: If anyone sets his heart on being an overseer, he desires a noble task. 2Now the overseer must be above reproach, the husband of but one wife, temperate, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, 3not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. 4He must manage his own family well and see that his children obey him with proper respect. 5(If anyone does not know how to manage his own family, how can he take care of God's Church?) 6He must not be a recent convert, or he may become conceited and fall under the same judgment as the devil. 7He must also have a good reputation with outsiders, so that he will not fall into disgrace and into the devil's trap. 8Deacons, likewise, are to be men worthy of respect, sincere, not indulging in much wine, and not pursuing dishonest gain. 9They must keep hold of the deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience. 10They must first be tested; and then if there is nothing against them, let them serve as deacons. 11In the same way, their wives are to be women worthy of respect, not malicious talkers but temperate and trustworthy in everything. 12A deacon must be the husband of but one wife and must manage his children and his household well. 13Those who have served well gain an excellent standing and great assurance in their faith in Christ Jesus."

Leadership will be entrusted and encouraged to pray for and counsel people, and teach and preach the Word of God. Obviously, Pastors can not do everything. Therefore, we want people to become accustomed to trusting the Leaders of this ministry in all areas. The Leaders will be expected to faithfully pray and study the Word of God. They will be given the authority to lead in a Godly manner. Every decision that will be made will be well-thought out and prayed through. When necessary or when the Spirit leads, a fast will be declared.

There will be numerous ministries including but not limited to: Youth, Pre-Teen, Children, Parenting, Singles, Marriage/Relationship, Life Groups, Music, Prison, Food, and Outreach. Every ministry will be prayerfully considered and led with excellence. As the Lord leads, other ministries will be established.

There is a desperate urgency in our hearts for the lost to be rescued and to be set free once and for all, by the very hand of God. We can not do it alone!
